<p>2.</p>	<p>TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION</p> <p>2.1.2.1 The bidder/s must provide proof that they have a local heavy duty processing plant for processing copper and optic fibre cable that consists of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Washing plants • Separation plants • Poly and PVC processing plants • Ability to process all jelly products <p>2.1.2.2 Optic and other non-recyclable material disposal capability and capacity to process these materials. All processes have to comply with the carbon footprint legislation. The bidder/s has to submit written proof by means of disposal certificates that they are capable to dispose these materials.</p> <p>2.1.2.3 The bidder/s must supply Telkom with a clearance certificate from the South African Police (SAPS).</p> <p>2.1.2.4 The bidder/s must supply Telkom with a valid reseller's license certificate. The license must indicate if the bidder/s can re-sell scrap in the original form and/or processed form.</p>
